The U.S. Department of Education determines a student's dependency status for financial aid purposes through a series of questions on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Examples of third-party professionals include judges, government officials, case workers, clergy and high school counselors. Letters of documentation need to be on official agency letterhead and/or notarized.

We are unable to take into consideration the following reasons:

- Parent refusal to contribute to the student's education.
- Parent unwillingness to provide information on the FAFSA.
- Parent unwillingness to provide income verification documentation.
- Parent does not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes.
- Student demonstrates total self-sufficiency.
- 2. A completed 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), if you have not already submitted it yourself online.
- 3. Copy of your 2020 Federal Tax Return Transcript unless you used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool when you completed your FAFSA. –OR–
- Please check here if you did not file or were not required to file a Federal Tax Return for 2020.
 And, attach all W-2s and Verification of Non-filing Letter for 2020 from the IRS: Form 4506-T.

If your appeal is approved, you will be notified by email and the financial aid office will file your 2022-2023 FAFSA electronically as an independent student. If your request is denied and you still wish to apply for financial aid, you must file the FAFSA yourself providing parental information.
