

Need help completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)?

Prior to the appointment go to pin.ed.gov to create a Personal Identification Number (PIN) this will allow the student (and parent, if applicable) to electronically sign the FAFSA and other federal student aid documents.

Items needed for your appointment

1. Lakeland student ID card or Driver's License or ID issued by the State.
2. Income earned for 2013 for student, spouse, and for parents if applicable.
 - 2013 Federal Tax Return
 - 2013 W-2's
 - For a Non-tax filer without W-2s calculate the amount earned in 2013
 - For dependent students if both parents reside in the same home, regardless of their marital status you must bring income information for both parents
3. Child support (if applicable)
 - Total amount received in 2013
 - Total amount paid in 2013
4. Untaxed income (if applicable)
 - Housing, food and other living allowances paid to members of the military, clergy and others
 - Veteran's non-education benefits
 - Money received or paid on the student's behalf
 - Other untaxed income
5. Assets
 - Current balance of cash, savings and checking accounts
 - Net worth of real estate (Do not include the home you live in. Net worth means current value minus debt owed on the real estate.)
 - Net worth of current businesses and/or investment farms (Do not include a family farm or family business with 100 or fewer full-time or full-time equivalent employees.)

If you have already filed a FAFSA for 2014-15 but did not list Lakeland Community College as a school choice you can make a correction to your FAFSA. Go to fafsa.gov and add Lakeland (school code is: 006804).
