All documents must be official and from third party professionals (not originating from the student, family or friends). Examples of third party professionals include judges, government officials, clergy and high school counselors. Letters of documentation need to be on agency letterhead and/or notarized.

- 3. 2011-2012 completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

If your request is denied, the FAFSA will be returned to you. If you still wish to apply for financial aid, you must file the FAFSA yourself using parental information.
