

If you are planning to take summer classes at Lakeland Community College, you may be eligible to receive financial aid.

For Lakeland to determine your aid eligibility you must:

- Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\) online](#). Lakeland's federal school code is 006804. Lakeland will receive the results of your FAFSA within 3-5 business days.
- Check your Lakeland email regularly; you will be emailed if there is any additional information needed to process your financial aid.
- Register for summer classes; after you register, if Lakeland has received your FAFSA and all requested documents, allow 3-5 business days for financial aid for summer to be offered and for you to be able to view your summer financial aid offer online through myLakeland.

Your summer financial aid eligibility will be calculated using your enrollment as of the Pell Recalculation date (end of the 100% refund period) of your earliest class. Please visit [Important Dates](#) for specific deadline dates. Your aid will not be adjusted if you add a class after your summer Pell Recalculation date.

Federal regulations allow for increased Pell Grant eligibility within an aid year (Year-Round Pell). If eligible, you may attend full-time (12 or more credit hours) for the summer, fall, and spring semester and receive your full-time Pell grant eligibility for all three semesters.

You must be seeking a degree or eligible certificate at Lakeland to be eligible for summer financial aid. In addition, you must have attended during the previous academic year or plan on attending the fall semester. If you are seeking a degree from another college, contact the financial aid office at that college to inquire how you may receive summer funding while attending Lakeland as a transient (visiting) student.
